FUN WAYS TO LEARN AT HOME SENSORY SCAVENGER HUNT

Science Spot: Senses allow us to observe and understand the world around us. There are five main ways we can do this: through sight (eyes), touch (fingers/skin), smell (nose), taste (tongue) and hearing (ears). Our senses send messages through receptor cells to our brain, using our nervous system to deliver them.

Sound

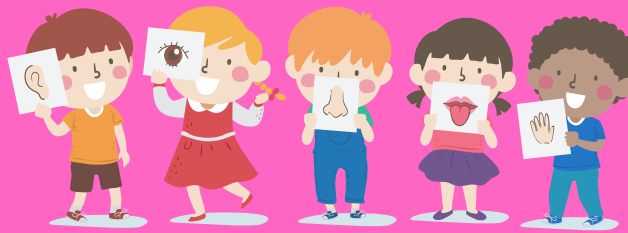
A song bird singing
